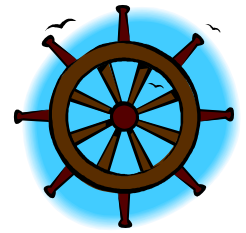

Our second “bring your own meat to grill and a plate to share” social was another success, with everyone enjoying an evening of fellowship and great food. We followed the dinner with a full moon sail (under an actual full moon with no clouds). It was a spectacular night of sailing with five boats going out. Prior to the social, we had guests from the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary who conducted

several vessel safety checks and then stayed to join us for dinner. We are going to post their contact info in the club house so you can contact them to do the safety check on your boat. It’s a good exercise to insure you comply with all state and federal regulations. The Auxiliary cannot ticket or fine you if you do not comply; it is only an educational exercise. They provided us with the placards and information that we didn’t have to bring us into compliance.

Next month we are going to have a cookout for our social on September 20th, so be on the docks around 5:00pm so we can get a head count on number of participants. We have a full schedule of events and races from the cruise to Goose Pond on the 30th to the Annual Meeting on November 15th. In fact, we only have two weekends from now till then that we don’t have an activity planned, so keep checking the schedule and come join in on the fun.

Start planning on attending the Annual Meeting on November 15th at Gunter’s Landing. We are planning a bigger and better event than last year (which may have been our biggest event ever), with presentations by the owners, election of new officers and voting on new bylaws. Charlie Rains is the chair of the nomination committee, so please contact him if you are willing to serve as either an officer or as a Board member or would like to nominate someone from the club. We have been working hard to put together a new set of bylaws that more closely reflect how we actually manage the club. We plan to have the draft bylaws published next month for all to see and comment on. We will vote on their adoption at the annual meeting – so stay tuned and let us know your comments and ideas between September and the Annual Meeting.

The club house is looking great, with a new paint job, patio fireplace and chairs. We have new furniture ordered which should be here before the next marina open house on October 11. The owners have remodeled and furnished the house on the hill and it is for rent at \$225 per night with a two night minimum on the weekend.
